Year 7 Catch-up Premium Report
for 2017-2018

The Year 7 Catch-Up premium provides additional funding to schools to accelerate the progress of identified pupils in English and Mathematics. The funding is aimed at Year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in the Key Stage 2 national curriculum tests in reading and/or mathematics. The funding enables the school to deliver additional support, such as individual tuition or intensive support in small groups, for those pupils that most need it, so that they catch up with their peers.

Y7 Catch-up Premium 2017-18

We have identified 6 pupils eligible for the catch-up premium in the academic year 2017-18. This is made up from:

Literacy	5 pupils
Numeracy	4 pupils
BOTH literacy and numeracy	3 pupils

The amount of funding for 2017-18 will be approximately £2000. We plan to spend this in a variety of ways, including:

- Small group and one to one tuition
- Resources to support learning
- Teachers and Learning Support Assistants offering extra intervention and support in literacy and numeracy
- In-class support for literacy and numeracy
- Supervised buddy reading programme
- Attendance support resources

Y7 Catch-up Premium 2016-17

We identified 11 pupils eligible for the catch-up premium in the academic year 2016-17. This was made up from:

Literacy	8 pupils
Numeracy	10 pupils
BOTH literacy and numeracy	7 pupils
