Speke Hall is a rare Tudor timber-framed manor house in a most unusual setting on the banks of the River Mersey. Restored and brought back to life in the 19th century, it is a unique and beautiful mixture of Tudor simplicity and Victorian Arts and Crafts' aesthetics.

Could you please arrive at school for 09:00, we will be leaving school by coach shortly after. We will be back for the end of school. Please ensure your child meditates at home before school on this occasion. We will be returning in time for afternoon meditation.

All pupils should be in full school uniform (including correct school shoes) and should remember to bring a packed lunch, which we recommend they bring in a backpack (school bought or other type) or otherwise in a disposable bag.
