Dear Primary Phase Parents and Carers,

This academic year we are changing the way we report to you on your child's progress.

Parents Evenings:

There will be 2 parents' evenings per year. The first in October - focusing on how your child is settling in, their individual targets and the expectations for their particular year group in core subjects. The second parents evening will happen in March, focusing on your child's progress, recent assessments and looking at specific pieces of work (e.g. writing).

Reporting to Parents:

We will send one report home per year which will include written details of how your child is getting on in all subjects, including CbIDS. The report will be sent home in the Summer Term and will be far more detailed than the termly reports we have sent home in the past. It will also include whether your child is below, at or above national expectations in reading, writing, maths and science. We feel this way of reporting will be far more personal to each child, celebrating their achievements in school which fits with one of Maharishi's key principles of teaching; receptivity is best accomplished when teachers speak and act in a way that upholds and encourages pupils through their positive attention to every step of the pupil's progress and achievement.

Having 2 parents evenings and 1 detailed report per year is in line with many other schools. Teachers will continue to assess the pupils and record their progress and attainment termly on our internal systems which will be discussed at parents evenings.
