Hello Year 11,

This is your Mock Examination Newsletter, please take time to read this as it provides you with instructions and guidance on what will be required during the mock examination period (19th – 30th November 2018) and will help to prepare you for the exam period June 2019.

Morning exams start at 9:10am (9:00 for TM) and the afternoon exams start at 1.40pm (1:30 for TM). Please don't be late for exams, get in the habit now of arriving on time at least 5 mins before. Please see the attached Mock exam time table.

Note: Please be aware that if you are late during the GCSE exams June 2019 this will not only impact on you, but also everyone sitting the exam, the invigilator and the exams officer. It is possible that you may not be allowed to sit the exam if you are deemed as very late.

EQUIPMENT

Students should bring the appropriate stationery to the exams including:

- **Black ballpoint pens** only (including spare pens)
- Pencils (including spare sharpened pencils)
- Ruler
- Protractor
- Pair of compasses
- Rubber
- Scientific Calculator (no cover)

All stationery should be kept in a see through pencil case. It is your responsibility to provide and bring your equipment for each exam. The school has limited spare equipment, so please do not rely on this being available.

Note: During the actual GCSE exams at the start of the exam the front of the exam paper is read out this will tell you what equipment you are permitted to use.

Conduct for Mock Exams

- Make sure mobile phones are handed in.
- Check you have your equipment in a clear bag.
- Be prepared to empty pockets out, no papers allowed in the room.
- Bottled water is allowed in a clear bottle remove all labels.
- Stop talking when asked to (outside the exam room).
- NO talking once you are in the exam room, if you have a question put your hand up.
- If you need a toilet break put your hand up.
- Write clearly in black pen.

Not permitted

- Liquid paper
- Erasable pens
- Gel pens
