The workshop will include the role that Florence Nightingale played in helping soldiers during the Crimean War and what her team of nurses achieved at Scutari Hospital. They will also explore the contents of a wooden doctor case and draw medicine bottles and implements that a doctor would have had during the Crimean War.
